- "More houses, more people, more kids"
- Judge Schell: Self-evident
- But.... history is more complicated (out-migration; birth rates; etc.)

FOUR COUNTS IN FAVOR OF PLAINTIFFS: Process (1); Drafting (2); Substantive (1)

COUNT ONE: (process) The Virginia Code and the Initiating Resolution

- When is a resolution not a resolution?
- Answer: When one omits the phrase "The County Board is resolving to amend the zoning ordinance"
- **Irony**: the Judge's next sentence: "Instead, the resolution authorizes the advertisement of public hearings...."
- Odds of County success on appeal: ____%

COUNT THREE: (substantive) The Virginia Code and Studies

- Virginia Code Section 15.2.2284 and the "fairly debatable test"
- Key phrase: "...the lack of any consideration of the effect of additional sewer water and stormwater on the local laterals from single-family homes along the length of the sewer system."
- What system? Whose laterals?
- Odds of County success on appeal: ____%
- Odds of General Assembly amending Code section 15.2-2284 : ____%
- Would the Virginia Supremes remand the case for clarity?

COUNT FOUR: (drafting) Permits, and Delegation of Legislative Authority

- Unlawful delegation of legislative authority
- What is a special exception?
- When is a permit not a permit?
- What to make of this wording from the judge? "The evidence also clearly shows that, for the purposes of this statute, the zoning in the affecting area has not changed. The zoning is still single-family homes on the appropriate lots."
- Odds of County success on appeal: ____%

COUNT SEVEN: (drafting) The Dillon Rule and Landscaping Provisions

- "...the municipality must act within the powers expressly or impliedly conferred upon it by the General Assembly."
- "The provisions of the EHO regarding tree canopy are directly contrary to the requirements of 15.2-961." ("exceed those requirements")
- Odds of success on appeal: ____%
- Is any alleged violation "severable"?

JUDGE'S SUMMARY

- "<u>Count Three</u>: The Board failed to reasonably consider several required factors in Virginia Code 15.2-2284."
- If I were a Supreme, I might ask...
- Which factors specifically?
- If the threshold is not met....tell me, what is the threshold?

WHAT CAN THE COUNTY DO-in addition to...or instead of.... FILING AN APPEAL?

- Enact a new EHO?
- Enact new amendments...anyone willing to amend the R-10 District to allow duplexes?
- Amend site plan regulations to make them less onerous?
- Approve the existing applications by converting them to site plan applications?
